Grade 8 ELECTIVE COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



Grade 8 students at Burnaby South have an opportunity to take a variety of Elective Courses. These courses will expose them to areas of special interest, which may lead to more detailed study in later grades.



Art Studio: Visual Arts 8

- Art 8 is designed to develop students skills and creative thinking in the following areas of study: Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Ceramics, Graphics, and Textiles
- \Rightarrow All artwork is created in class, with little to no homework, and all art materials are supplied to students.



- \Rightarrow Art: Media Arts 8 is an introductory course to many different media possibilities.
- ⇒ Students learn the basics of video production, animation, photography, music composition, and web page design.
- ⇒ The course is largely practical and involves students doing hands-on activities and group projects in class as well as outside of
- \Rightarrow Software used include iMovie, Garageband, Adobe Premiere Pro, Flash, Dreamweaver, Photoshop and many Web2.0 applications.



Drama 8

- \Rightarrow Drama 8 is an introductory course which offers students opportunities to develop various dramatic skills to deepen their understanding of themselves and the world through imagination and interaction.
- ⇒ Drama encourages students to: trust themselves and others; reflect on thoughts, feelings and beliefs; take risks within a dramatic context; and actively express themselves in body and voice.
- ⇒ Through a variety of theatre games, improvisation, exercises, and projects students will be introduced to basic techniques to create theatre and explore themes and situations.
- \Rightarrow Students are encouraged to approach the course with an open mind, kind attitude towards others and willingness to enthusiastically participate.



Dance Foundations 8

- ⇒ Through daily warm ups, across the floor work, teacher led choreography, and team building exercises, this beginner level course will teach students basic dance technique and performance qualities developed from the elements of movement.
- ⇒ Through a progressive approach, students can expect to improve in strength, flexibility, stamina, balance, and coordination; in addition to building confidence and building trust with one another.
- ⇒ Students can expect to work individually, small groups, and as a large class in preparation for the Year End Dance Recital

Concert Choir: Choral Music 8

- ⇒In Choir: Concert Junior 8, students will refine their skills as a singer by learning healthy vocal technique progressing to a higher level of skill as you move from Junior to Senior Choir.
- ⇒ We offer many performance experiences & fields trips to allow our students the opportunity to hear the best musicians in Vancouver.



Beginner Band Beginner: Instrumental Music 8

- ⇒ Concert Band Beginner 8 is an introductory course in which students are introduced to the maintenance, technique and rudiments of a selected band instrument. Concepts such as articulation, embouchure, blend, balance, tone and style are introduced to form a foundation of musical awareness that encourages expression, reflection and performance.
- ⇒ There is an Instrument Rental/First Lesson Night in September, where Parents can purchase/rent their instrument for the Year.

Concert Band: Instrumental Music 8 (Prerequisite: 1 year Band Experience)

- ⇒ In Concert Band Junior 8, students will refine their skills as a musician by learning to play a musical instrument at a progressively higher level of skill.
- ⇒ We offer many extra musical experiences and field trips to allow our students the opportunity to hear the best musicians in Vancouver and to try new musical ideas.

Chamber Choir: Choral Music 8 AM 7:30am Class

- ⇒ Chamber Choir offers those students with is a performing group open to students who have previous choral experience and a basic knowledge of music theory.
- ⇒ The course integrates advanced elements of choral music though rehearsal, analysis, and performance. Instruction in music theory and sight singing are covered in this class.
- ⇒ **NOTE:** Students must also be registered in Concert Choir: Choral Music 8

Orchestra: Instrumental Music 8 AM 7:30am Class (Prerequisite: 3 years String Experience)

- We are one of the few schools in the province that offers a full symphony orchestra class.
- ⇒ This class offers those students with 3 years minimum on a stringed instrument an ensemble experience (Brass & Woodwind players are accepted by teacher recommendation)
