


ATTENTION ALL AP STUDENTS

Registration **deadline is Tuesday, November 1st, 2022.** Any questions, please see Mr. Lee in Room A139 at lunch time.






Attention Grade 12s

Attention Grade 12s, the Literacy 12 Graduation Assessment will be held on Wednesday, November 2nd and Thursday, November 3rd. To find out your date, time and location of when you are writing the assessment, you should have already received a letter from your English 12 teacher's class that outlines when and where you are doing the Literacy 12 assessment. You can also look at the lists posted outside computer labs B119 and B213.

A special review session will take place in the Michael J. Fox Theatre on Friday October 28th during flex time (8:40 am to 9:25 am) to help you prepare for the Literacy 12 assessment. In order, for you to graduate, all grade 12s must complete this assessment. Also, universities may be looking at your results from this assessment for their admission purposes.
