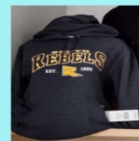

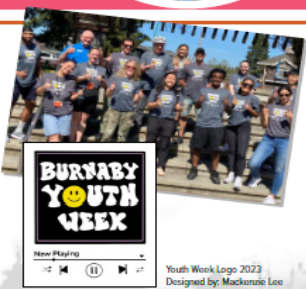
Help us celebrate Burnaby Youth Week, a week of fun celebrations, building a strong connection between youth and their community.
