#### Math 9 Honours Entrance Exam Requirements:

##### 1. Exam Date and Duration:

The entrance exam for students who signed up for  
Math 9 Honors for the next school year will be held  
in the first week of March date will be decided.

Students will write the exam with you (Math  
teacher) during their regular math class.

The exact date for the exam will be scheduled by the  
Math department. I will be printing the exam and  
gave it to you before that date.

Students will have one hour to complete the  
assessment.

##### 2. Question Format:

The exam comprises 15 written questions.

##### 3. Formula Sheets:

Mathematical formulas will be provided on Formula  
Sheets.

Formulas cover perimeter, area, volume, and surface  
area for various geometric shapes and objects.

##### 4. Required Knowledge:

Students are expected to be familiar with all topics  
covered in Grade 8

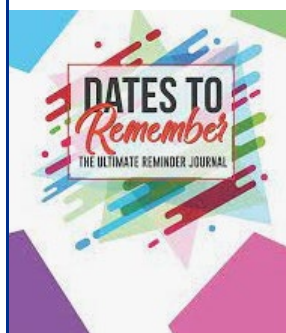
