GINGERBREAD DECORATING COMPETITION!

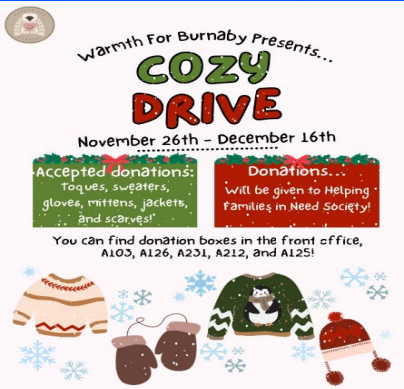
