5 Days of Winter Holidays Fun

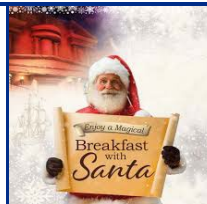
Please join the Interact Club to celebrate the last five days of school.

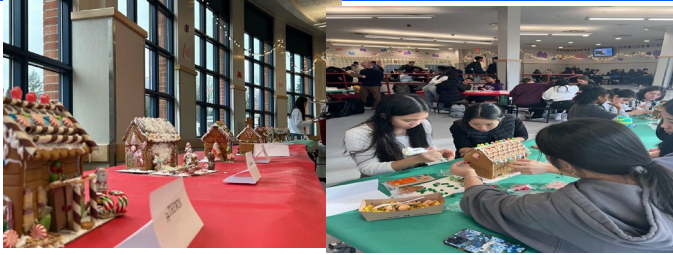


December 19th – Cards/Button (on sale near B119) send your friends cards or buttons



December 20th – Hot Coco (main entrance) treat yourself to a warm drink (\$0.00) 8:45 – 9:10 am

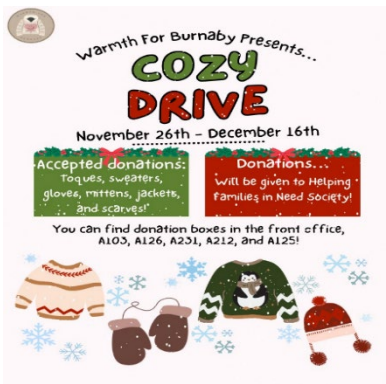




GINGERBREAD DECORATING COMPETITION!
