



## Important Information for Gr. 8s who are interested in Math 9 Honours

If you are interested in taking Gr. 9 Honours, please read the following information.

### **Entrance Exam Requirement**

You will be required to write an entrance exam. The exam will take place during your regular Math period on:

Monday, March 31, 2025 & Tuesday, April 1, 2025

### The exam will cover the following units from Math 8:

- Fraction Operations
- Integers
- Perfect Squares, cubes, and Pythagorean theorem
- Ration, rate, and proportion reasoning
- Percents
- Surface area
- Volume
- Solving linear equations

The exam will also include some math contest style questions, similar to those found in the Gauss 8 and CNML 8 Math contests.
