Burnaby South's School Leaving Ceremony will take place on **Wednesday, May 20, 2026**, at SFU Convocation Mall.

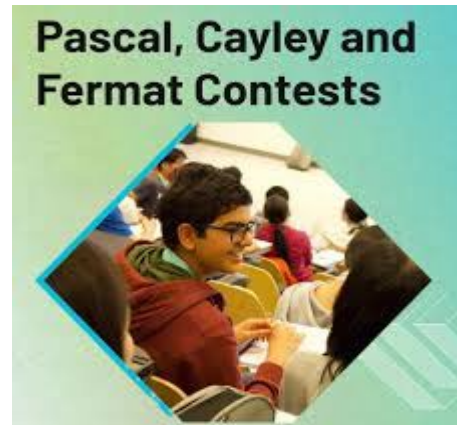
Students who wish to participate must complete the following payments:

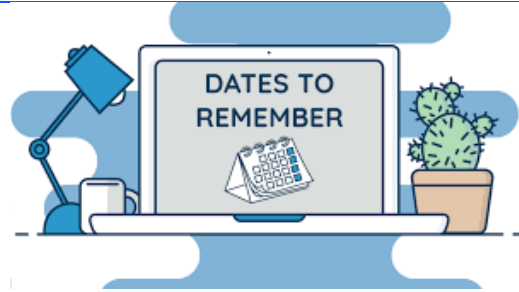
